## Town Council Update (Mike Ainsworth and Mary Catherine O'Neill)

- The Town Council shares several areas of focus for upcoming work
- Improving communication of news and events is a priority
- The offer from the town to promote School Council activities and the reciprocation of the school sharing town news through newsletters and the SC Facebook group
- Canada Day festivities will be shared with the school events including a parade, bicycle decoration competition and unveiling of outdoor exercise equipment
- There is the opportunity for the school to have a display at the event
- Civic Award nominations are due at the end of the week

- Yard Update: The first draft of the Master Plan has been shared back to the school. Will be sharing with community in upcoming newsletter
- Upcoming:

- School Staffing Allocations
  - We are anticipating a school population of about 270
  - We have been allocated an additional kindergarten classroom
    - Total homerooms 11->12
    - Will be using Room 8B as the third kindergarten room

- Allocated 3 support staff
- Ms. Brisbin will be moving into a support role for Grade 1 literacy and social emotional learning, and intermediate literacy and transition to grade 9 de-streaming
- Ms. Wilson is looking forward to retirement. Ms. Mononen will be moving into her role next year
- We are welcoming Ms. Armstrong (kindergarten), Ms. Bonnar (planning), and one additional teacher yet to be hired
- School Councils Ministry Funding
  - Photocopying costs and communication between school and home
  - Currently at \$973
  - Can carry over \$500
  - Propose that we use \$500 to pay for paper agendas and Family Handbook
  - Approved

- School board still unable to connect with developers to timetable grading of surface and handover
